SENIOR PROGRAM PLANNER / SCHEDULER

Duties / Responsibilities:

The Senior Program Planner position is an addition to the PMO/Planning team; a team responsible for providing planning, risk and opportunity, and earned value management (EVMS) expertise to program proposal and execution teams. The current requirement is for one SIOP Planner and one Proposal Planner.

As a part of this team, the Senior Program Planner works closely with Program Managers, Financial Analysts and program teams to develop and deploy effective integrated master plans (IMP) and schedules (IMS) for proposals and programs. This position is also a highly visible participant in our internal business operations review process to ensure sound and consistent ongoing proposal and program execution. The Senior Program Planner also conducts training, assesses training gaps/needs, provides support, mentors CAMS, and formulates and recommends corrective action measures to PMO Management as needed. This role within the Program Management organization requires the individual to create and implement standard planning practices and tools consistent with Corporate Program Leadership and based on Raytheon accumulated best practices and to obtain Level 3 EV certification and Raytheon Planner certification (on-line and classroom training)

The position provides primary technical support for Planning/Scheduling development and maintenance into Earned Value (EV) process tools. Prepares and coordinates the plans and schedules for proposals and programs. Coordinates updated data from program CAMS for EV reporting. Aligns Proposal development WBS with established EV reporting tools using MSProject to Microframe Program Manager (MPM). Formulates and recommends corrective action measures such as schedule revisions, manpower adjustments, funding allocation and work requirements. Ensures the Integrated Master Schedules interface directly with financial tools for Earned Value Measurement and site resource planning (EStaff).

Education / Experience / Skills Required:

- Undergraduate Diploma or Degree in Business or related studies
- Direct experience with MS Project (including current experience using MS Project 2000 or higher)
- Knowledge and experience with Earned Value (EVMS) methodologies for Integrated Master Schedules
- Management and planning of complex programs involving design, development, manufacturing and field deployment of Air Traffic Control and High Frequency Surface Wave Radar (HFSWR) systems.

- Understanding of the data requirements for exporting files from MS Project to MicroFrame Program Manager (MPM). Ability to analyze schedules to determine critical path and evaluate impact of changes. Proven ability to manage plans for multiple programs at the same time.
- Critical Chain concepts and familiarity with ProChain software would be assets for this position. Familiar with RTN E-Staff resource reporting requirements.
- ARM experience or equivalent schedule risk analysis tools is desirable
