Obsolescence Management Specialist

We are presently seeking an Obsolescence Management Specialist to monitor the availability status of electronic components that comprise the various products manufactured, repaired and overhauled by Raytheon Calgary, as well as any test equipment under the company's responsibility.

Job Duties:

- Create/maintain a comprehensive database of electronic components to be monitored for obsolescence. This may also include mechanical components such as pins, cables, etc
- Input and analyze data in the Company's logistics database
- Monitor alerts from Government Industry Data Exchange Program and Original Equipment Manufacturers who specify parts and products that the manufactures are discontinuing
- Access alerts and indicate which discontinuances impact the components that are monitored
- Research each component: the quantities per equipment on hand and the Canadian Forces Supply System quantities; their next higher assemblies; failure rates and usage over a determined number of years
- Forecast the quantities required to sustain the various product lines and when necessary, make recommendations on the components to buy
- Work with various departments by providing assistance locating sources for hard to find components
- Follow Quality Assurance standards and ISO 9000 policies and procedures to ensure the company meets specific military standards and accurate traceability to information sources
- Generate various reports for internal and external customers by indicating availability status of each component and assembly
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements:

- Post secondary diploma in a technical discipline, preferably in the electronic field
- 2 years previous work experience in the electronic and/or defence industry
- Strong computer skills with experience using the Microsoft Office suite of programs and strong internet searching skills and experience with database programs
- Strong communication skills both oral and written
- Strong organizational skills
- Must be able to work with minimal supervision
- Experience with the use of statistical principles would be an asset
- Experience working with CAD would be an asset
